



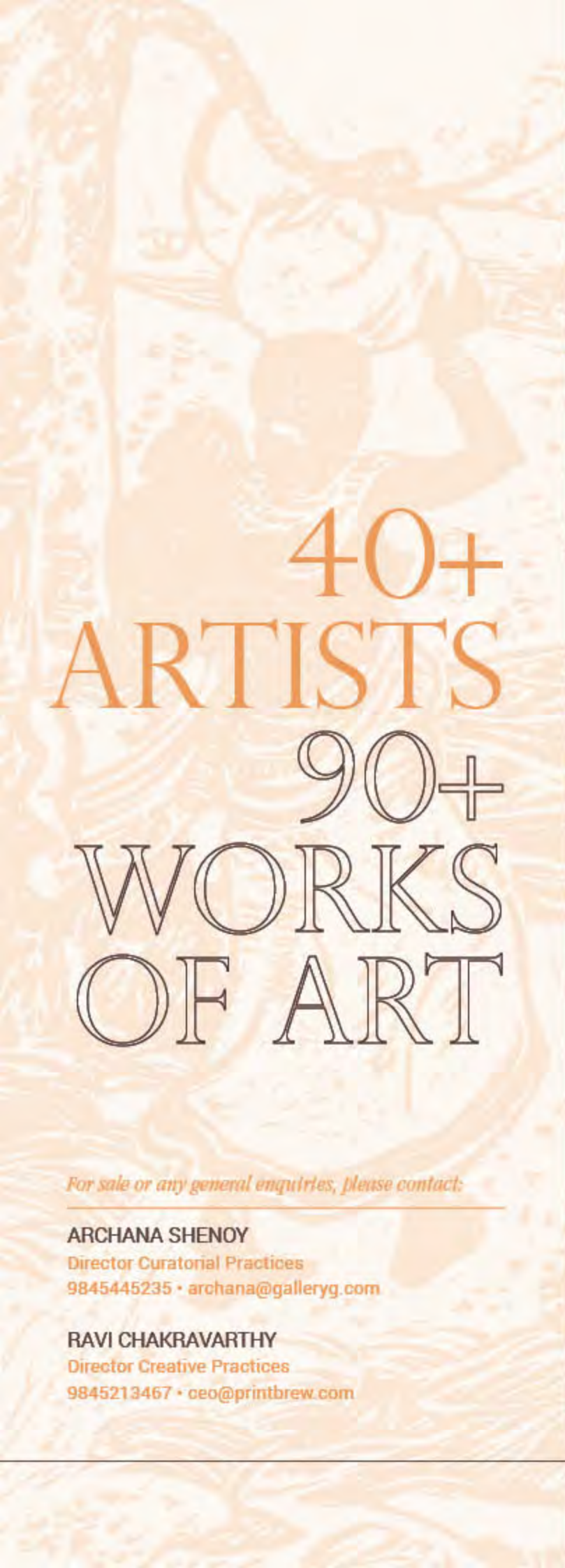

FROM EARLY WORKS TO CONTEMPORARY
VOICES OF THE EASTERN REGION

Curatorial note by Kallol Bose, Kolkata

This exhibition presents a dynamic India – encompassing Bengal, Bihar, Odisha, and Jharkhand – bringing together master painters rooted in the legacy of the Bengal School alongside contemporary practitioners who are actively reshaping the region's artistic landscape. *The Masters & The Modern, From Early Works To the Contemporary Voices of the Eastern Region* weaves a rich tapestry of evolving ideas and imaginations, interlacing enduring threads of the past with the vibrant presence of the present.

The luminous idioms of Bengal's master painters – such as Dhirendranath Brahma, Sunil Madhav Sen, and Sudhir Munsri – form the foundation of the exhibition. Their works embody a refined sensibility marked by lyricism, restraint, and an acute aesthetic awareness. Complementing them are the modern masters, including Jogen Chowdhury, Suhas Roy, Sunil Das and Paritosh Sen, whose practices signalled decisive departures from earlier stylistic conventions while retaining the spirit and ethical grounding of their predecessors.

The exhibition is organised into four sections: artists aligned with the lineage of the Bengal School; modern painters who carried the banner of change in Eastern India; contemporary practitioners engaging with current modes of artmaking; and works rooted in the Indian Style. Once central to the curriculum of the Government College of Art and Craft under the guidance of E. B. Havell and Abanindranath Tagore, the Indian Style sought to revive indigenous visual traditions in response to colonial influences. In today's globalised art environment, this practice has become nearly defunct. Through the works of Stuti Laha and Partha Sarathi Bhattacharjee, the exhibition recalls this historic idiom, not as nostalgia, but as a reflective engagement with a formative artistic legacy.

The Masters & The Modern stands as an ode to legacy – preserved within collective memory and continually transformed by time. The works engage ecological and political realities with a balance of simplicity and sensuality, traversing realms of familiarity and imagination.

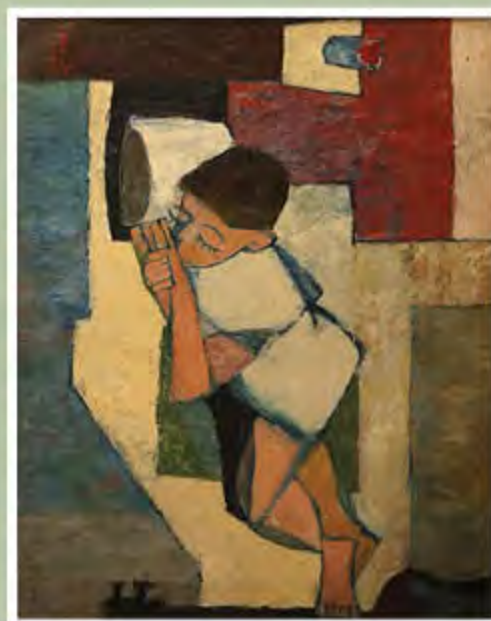

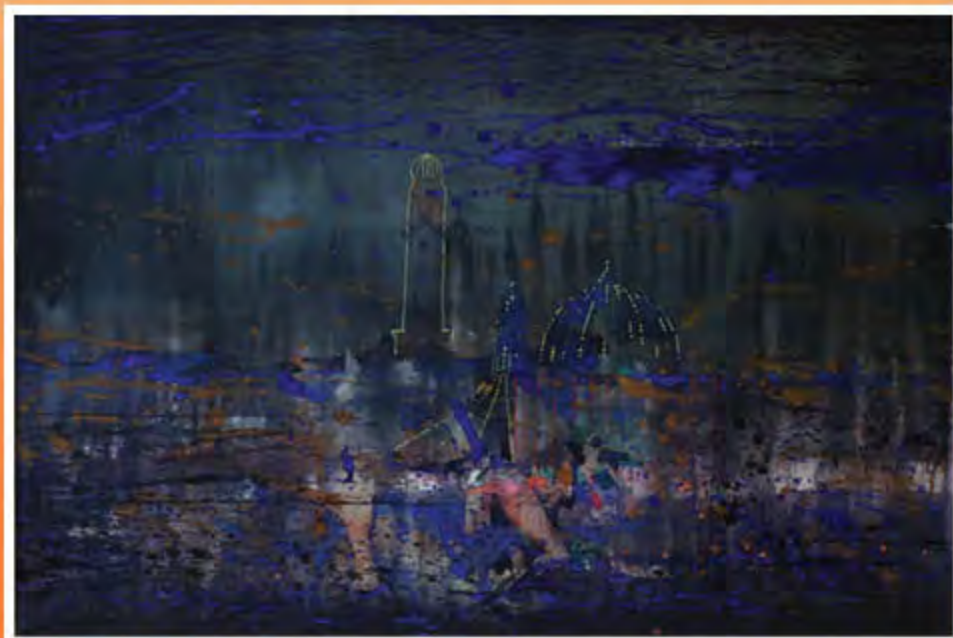

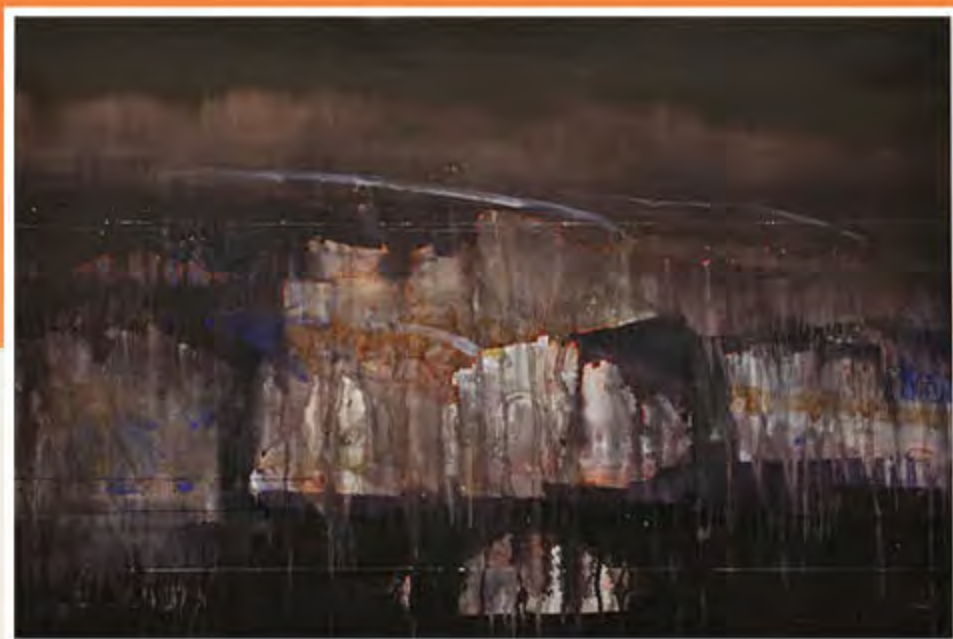

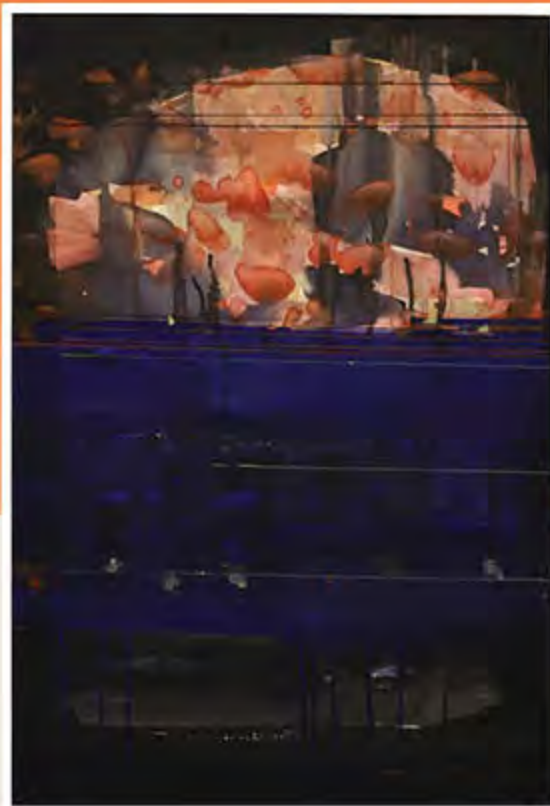

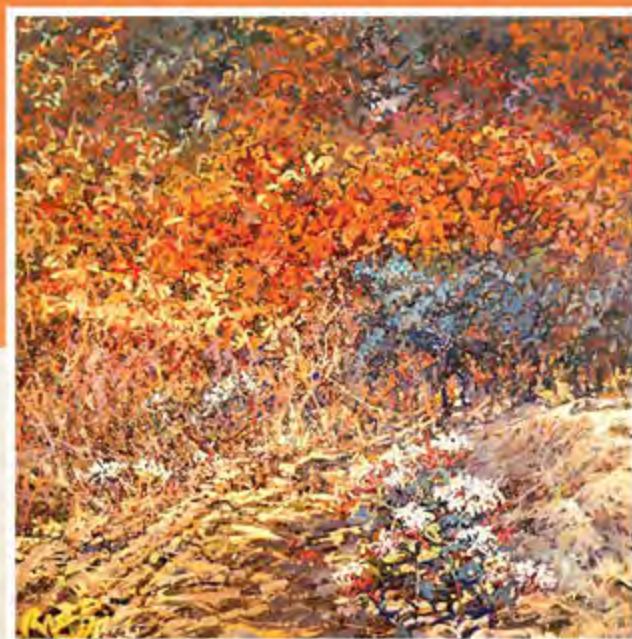

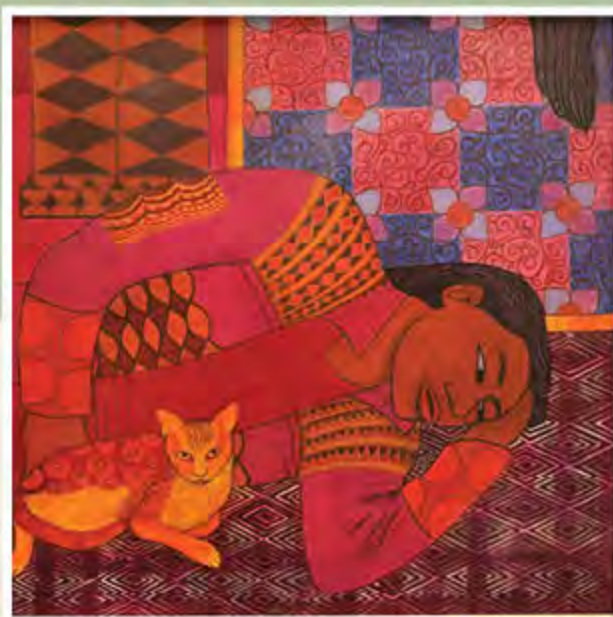
