Curatorial note by Kallol Bose, Kolkata

or me it is an intimate return to the artistic language that shaped my earliest ways of seeing art. Bengal has never been a static idea — it is a living rhythm, layered with memory, emotion, conflict, poetry and stubborn hope. In bringing these works together, I wanted to trace that continuum: how artists from different generations reinterpret the familiar and the inherited, yet speak to the urgency of our present moment.


Each work here carries its own pulse — sometimes quiet, sometimes forceful — but always connected to the deeper cultural soil of Bengal. Whether through figuration, abstraction, symbolism or atmosphere, these artists reimagine the region not as nostalgia, but as a breathing landscape of thought and feeling. What emerges is a Bengal that is both ancient and utterly contemporary, rooted yet restless.

It gives me great joy to share this selection at Madras Art Weekend - a dialogue between heritage and renewal, memory and imagination. I hope viewers will encounter and experience the Bengal I believe in: evolving, expressive and bound by a timeless artistic spirit.












